



## Gyanvapi row: Fast-track court to pronounce verdict on plea seeking 'shivling' worship on Nov 8

VARANASI, OCT 27 /- / A fast-track court hearing a plea seeking permission to allow worship of the "shivling" claimed to have been found in the Gyanvapi mosque complex here will pronounce its verdict on November 8. Advocate Anupam Dwivedi, appearing for the Hindu side, said that the fast-track court of Civil Judge (Senior Division) Mahendra Pandey heard the arguments of both sides and reserved its order on the suit till November 8. On May 24, plaintiff Kiran

Singh, who is general secretary of Vishwa Vedic Sanatan Sangh, had filed the suit in the Varanasi district court seeking a ban on the entry of Muslims into the Gyanvapi complex, handing over the complex to the Sanatan Sangh and permission to offer prayers at the "shivling". On May 25, district court Judge A K Vishvesh ordered the transfer of the suit to a fast-track court. In this suit, Varanasi district magistrate, police commissioner, Anjuman Intezamia

Committee that is managing the Gyanvapi mosque and Vishwanath Temple Trust have been made respondents. On April 26, a lower court (civil judge-senior division) that was earlier hearing a plea by a group of women seeking permission for daily worship of idols of Hindu deities on the mosque's outer walls had ordered a videographic survey of the Gyanvapi complex and the Hindu side had claimed a "shivling" was found during the exercise. However, the

Muslim side has maintained that the object was part of the water fountain mechanism at the "wazookhana" reservoir - where devotees carry out ablutions before offering namaz. On May 20, the Supreme Court had transferred the case from a civil judge (senior division) to a district judge, saying looking at the "complexities" and "sensitivity" of the issue, it is better if a senior judicial officer with an experience of over 25-30 years handles this case. ## Haryana CM Manohar Lal Khattar says he had no role in Ram Rahim's parole

NEW DELHI, OCT 27 /- / Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar has said he had no role in the parole granted to Dera Sacha Sauda chief Gurmeet Ram Rahim Singh as jails have their own rules. Ram Rahim, who is serving a 20-year jail term for raping two women disciples at his ashram in Sirsa, was granted parole for 40 days last week. The decision to grant him parole ahead of the Adampur bypoll in Haryana on November 3 and panchayat elections has triggered a furore. For the last few days, Ram Rahim has been holding online discourses from his Barnawa ashram in Uttar Pradesh. These discourses have been attended by scores of his followers, including many Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) leaders from Haryana. Asked about Ram Rahim's parole at a press conference here, Khattar said he had no role in it. "I had no role in this.... Courts announce imprisonment and a convict goes to jail. After that, the jail's rules apply to all the inmates," Khattar told the press conference organised on the completion of eight years of his government. Further asked about the timing of Ram Rahim's parole, the chief minister declined to comment, saying he had nothing more to say on the issue. Ram Rahim, along with four others, was also convicted last year for hatching a conspiracy to kill Ranjit Singh, a Dera manager, in 2002. The Dera chief and three others were convicted in 2019 for the murder of a journalist more than 16 years ago. In February, Ram Rahim was granted three weeks' furlough ahead of the Punjab Assembly polls. (PTI)

## J&K: Shopian admin says no migration; Kashmiri Pandits reject claim, resolve to never return

SRINAGAR, OCT 27 /- / Authorities in South Kashmir's Shopian attempted to put on a brave face by claiming no exodus of Kashmiri Pandits had taken place from the district but members of the minority community, who have since been camping in Jammu, ruled out having any plan to return to the Valley. While a verified Twitter handle of the Information and Public Relations department of Shopian claimed that the news about leaving of "Kashmiri non-migrant Hindu population" was "baseless", Ashwani Kumar Bhat, whose brother Puran Krishan Bhat was gunned down by terrorists on October 16, told reporters in Jammu that he has migrated and will never return to the valley. The authorities claimed on Twitter that "proper and robust security arrangements have been kept in place by the administration in the village. Even at other pockets of Kashmiri non-migrant Hindu habitations and villages, similar security arrangements are in place". Puran Krishan Bhat was killed by terrorists in Choudharygund area of Shopian at a place which had a minority police picket at 20 metres and an army camp nearby. The deceased's brother said, "We have migrated from there. I will never return. I swear by

my children, I will not return till the last breath of my life". Pointing towards his children, he said neither he will return to Kashmir nor allow his children to go there. "I have one hundred kanals (five hectares) of land there but I will never go back. Will I go there to die?" he asked. Bhat, who saw his brother dying in front of his eyes, said he will quit his government job but will not go back. "I do not need anything", he said. Bhat took a dig at the administration over their statement of deployment of police guards to protect them and said "when the killing of Sunil Kumar took place in Chatigam, we went to the SP of Shopian - who is a woman and Major Sahib (of the nearby army camp). We urged them to keep visiting our village - one time a day. Nobody helped us - nobody came here. We have not seen police guards - they themselves live in fear". The deceased's cousin said the administration is issuing statements about guards deployed in the village for security. "If they are issuing statements about guards, we should have seen them (visiting our village)". "We even do not know whether they (guards) have come for our security. They never came out", he said. The brother was seen airing his views on various television channels. Like him, another Choudharygund resident, who did not wish to be named, said he has left the

harvested apples in the compound of his house as life is precious. "God saved me as they wanted to hit me too. They had come back to my school a few days ago, but I was not there", he said. Another woman, who also shifted to Jammu, said they were living in fear. The nephew of the deceased said while authorities were making claims that adequate security arrangements had been made for the minorities, the "situation was totally different on the ground". "The police personnel posted on security duty always sat inside (their picket). Had they been outside, they would have been able to see the people. Ask anyone - ask Kashmiri Muslims, ask Hindus living there -- if they had seen them (cops)?" he said. As terrorists carried out a number of targeted killings recently, 10 Kashmiri Pandit families have left their village in the Shopian district out of fear and reached Jammu. The residents of Choudharygund said the recent terrorist attacks have triggered a fear psychosis among the Pandits who lived in Kashmir through the most difficult period of terrorism in the 1990s and did not leave their homes. "Ten families comprising 35 to 40 Kashmiri Pandits have migrated out of our village due to the fear psychosis," a resident of Choudharygund village who faced a death threat recently told PTI. ## Lack of funds, other factors delay housing scheme in AP; officials seek over Rs 2,000 Cr from CM

AMARAVATI, OCT 27 /- / The Housing Department has appealed to Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Y S Jagan Mohan Reddy for immediate release of Rs 2,361 crore to make progress in the construction of houses under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) in the state. The Government of India has already released Rs 4,032 crore under PMAY-U so far in the 2022-23 financial year but the AP government released only Rs 2,556 crore of the grant to the Housing Department, diverting another Rs 1,476 crore. Besides, of its proportionate share of Rs 1,389 crore, the state released only Rs 504 crore so far but stopped the balance citing "resource crunch", a senior official said. Payment of Rs 755 crore, including Rs 324 crore to the beneficiaries, has been pending, severely hampering the progress of the scheme. Over the last few years, the Centre sanctioned 16,84,502 houses to AP under PMAY-U but only 13,92,855 have been taken up for construction so far, the



official added. AP, which tops the country drawing over 57 per cent of the total PMAY-U grant this year, is expecting to get a total of Rs 5,000 crore. "The remaining Central share of Rs 1,476 crore and the state share of Rs 885 crore have to be released immediately to get the next instalment from the Centre in December. Housing Department officials told the Chief Minister at a high-level review meeting here on Wednesday. Housing department officials said Rs 324 crore has to be paid to the PMAY-U beneficiaries and another Rs 311 crore for land acquisition and land levelling work. Also, Rs 120 crore has to be paid for drinking water supply works taken up under the Jal Jeevan Mission. Meanwhile, officials also told the Chief Minister that the progress of the housing

programme has been vastly affected in the last few months due to various factors. While non-availability of funds is the main reason, "relentless rains" (20 per cent excess) have also compounded the crisis. Bad roads across the state have affected movement of vehicles carrying construction material to various places. "Workability has been adversely affected because of this," the Housing department officials told Reddy. Sand, a critical input, is in short supply. Stocks available in various depots have "exhausted" and refilling has not been possible as sand reaches remained non-operational because of floods. The state government planned to organise a massive function on December 21 to mark the completion of about five lakh houses but it could now be held only after January next year. (PTI)

## Man suffers burns after 'fire haircut' goes wrong at salon in Gujarat

VALSAD, OCT 27 /- / An 18-year-old man suffered severe burn injuries after his "fire haircut" went wrong at a salon in Vapi town of Gujarat's Valsad district, police said on Thursday. The fire haircut, which has gained popularity of late, is a process in which a hairdresser uses fire on the customer's hair to set it in style. A video clip of the Vapi incident, which took place on Wednesday, surfaced on social media in which the fire set on the victim's hair as part of the process was seen going out of control. The victim received burn injuries on his neck and chest and was taken to a hospital in Vapi from where he was referred to the Civil Hospital in Valsad, a Vapi town police station official said. The victim, resident of Bhadkora area in Vapi, had gone to get the "fire haircut" at the salon in Sulpad area, police said. Investigating officer Karamsinh Makwana said a process was underway to take the statements of the victim and the hairdresser. "We are trying to get the statement of the victim. He was admitted to the Civil Hospital in Valsad. We have learnt that from there he was taken to a hospital in Surat," Makwana said. As per primary information, the victim's upper body parts suffered severe burns after of some kind of a chemical was applied on his head for the haircut, police officials said. An investigation was on to ascertain which chemical was used for the 'fire haircut', they said. (PTI)
